Approved minutes from last meeting

- Remainder left in budget for this year.

Discipline Data: Starting to level out. We are in 3rd year tracking major discipline problems.

- Look and track areas for school discipline problems
- Currently 36 referrals.
- 2 students have 11 of 36 referrals.
- Playground and lunch room areas mostly.
- Staff communicating well with problems and issues.
- The goal is that these issues and problems are being reported.

Land Trust

- Focusing a lot on input from teachers as well as SCC members for what is needed.
- Teachers looking at the Data.
- Teachers set goals – CSIP / Land Trust
- It was proposed to use 5,000 dollars of Land Trust to use for our Behavior Assistant for full time for next school year. Title would be changed to MTSS Aid.
 - Presently he is working part time: 25 hours under 0050 and 3 hours under Cell Tower per week.
 - This would bump up his hours to 35 hours a week: 15 extra hours per week paid for by Land Trust or Cell Tower if there is budget for this. Julie will call district. If there are not enough funds, we want to add three hours a week to MTSS aide to be 28 hours week.
 - Oversee Recess Coaches for every grade level.
 - Train Recess Coaches for games during lunch recess.
 - Goal is to bump up, “kids feeling safe” in lunch room.

- It was also proposed that \$13,000 be spent for a Lexia Program for next year. (Only if we do not get a grant to cover it for next year.)
 - This program helps students and targets each individual student's needs in Language Arts.
 - It would be purchased for individual students that are struggling.
- It was proposed to maintain our 6 Reading Interventionists and 2 Dual Immersion Aides for next school year 2018-19.
- It was proposed that the extra 5000.00 or more left to be spent on Technology.
- It was proposed that Cell Tower money for next year, be used to purchase 1 Chromebook and 1 iPad lab to replace the two we have that are older and outdated.

All voted a yes on these issues and signed paperwork

School Safety Issues

- It was brought up about Safety. (Bullet/Proof back packs)
- Talked about our safety procedures. What is being done to make our school safer.
- Safe Utah APP
- It was suggested that at "Back to School Night", the Police Department be present to talk to parents about what they can do to keep their kids safe. Also safety questions/ answer period.
