

Oak Hollow Final Report 2018-2019

ELA

Goals:

Language: By Spring 2019, all kindergarten students will have at least 28 correct letter sounds as measured from the beginning of the year using the DIBELS Nonsense Word Fluency assessment. By Spring 2019, 85% of first grade students will show proficiency on the DIBELS Oral Reading Fluency from the beginning of the year. By Spring 2019, second grade students will grow by 35 words per minute on the DIBELS Oral Reading Fluency from the fall to the spring. By Spring 2019, third grade students will grow by 20 words per minute on the DIBELS Oral Reading Fluency from the fall to the spring. By Spring 2019, 80% of fourth graders will achieve above basic proficiency on the Reading Inventory assessment. By Spring 2019, all fifth-grade students will show 115-word increase using the Reading Inventory assessment from the fall to the spring.

Final Report:

While not every grade made their goal, Oak Hollow made growth in the area of English Language Arts (ELA). Our kindergarten set a goal of 100% and almost made it. Four kindergarten students did not make this goal. Our fourth-grade students made more than a year's growth on the Reading Inventory from fall to Spring. They did not technically make the goal, since only 74% were proficient on Reading Inventory. Many of our fourth graders were very low in the fall, but made great gains. Our fifth-grade class started with much higher proficiency scores on the Reading Inventory. Our fifth graders had 81% proficient with 109 lexile growth. The team set their goal at 115 lexile points, so they were just short.

Below is a data report for each grade, with the outcome and goal attainment for ELA.

Grade	Outcome	Goal Attainment
<i>Kindergarten</i>	96%	Goal was 100%. Only four students did meet the goal.
<i>First</i>	77%	No, goal was 85%. Only one class out of four made this goal
<i>Second</i>	36-word growth	Yes, goal was average growth of 35 words.
<i>Third</i>	28-word growth	Yes, goal was average growth of 20 words.
<i>Fourth</i>	74%	Yes and no. We had 152 point lexile growth but the goal was 80% proficiency
<i>Fifth</i>	109 lexile points	Yes and no. We had 81% proficiency in 5th grade and a 109 lexile growth. 109 is a year's growth band, but the team chose 115 points as the goal.

Expenditures:

We spent \$46,000 on reading interventionists and \$26,066 to purchase two I-pad carts. We carried over \$4,200 for 2019-2020
