Cell Tower Budget

- Remainder left in budget for this year.

Land trust budget

- Budget will carry over to next year. Required to use at least 90% of budget in the school year.
- Can only be used for what is stated in plan.
- Will plan for next year's Land Trust budget

Propose to Look at growth rate for Land Trust goal.

- Average on DIBELS- Looking at growth rate
- What is growth rate for each grade as a goal.
- Looking at trends over next year, instead of Benchmark numbers.
- Need to hire one more reading Interventionist in Land Trust.
 - Will cost \$6000- \$8000. A year.
- Renew: IXL Subscription (IXL is on students level)
- Questions were raised regarding possibly incorporating a reading comprehension option for 4-5th grade level.
 - Julie will look into it.
- After School tutoring program was proposed.
 - 2 days a week
 - Open to students by invitation only
 - Only students that don't meet bench mark.
 - 4-5 students per class
 - 1 hour after school
- Discussed possible Cell tower money used next year for accelerated higher-level students needs. Possible packets or chess or afterschool options.
 - Suggestion of having another option in Brain Boosters for a group of accelerated students to go to for needs.

- After School program for English or Math.
- Possible math intervention to challenge them as well.
- Work on Keyboard skills more. Julie will talk more to teachers about it for next year.

Wendy asked for upcoming CSIP to be approved.

- Committee unanimously approved CSIP plan.

Standards

- Take Professional Development to unpack standards for each grade level.
- Go beyond Reading Street to give more flexibility to teachers.

Bus and Recess duties for teachers

- Member asked about using Cell Tower funds to pay for aid bus and recess duties.
- Duties fall to teacher's responsibilities.
- Julie wants to use that money to build up learning technology in the school for all students. (Build chrome book and I Pad carts and labs) instead of paying for aides to cover these duties. Everyone was in agreement and it was approved.

Stop Sign - Vestry and Adobe Park road.

- Wendy will pursue it. Will promise to talk in mayors meeting regarding issue.
- Will report about it in September.
